## U.S. Patent and Trademark Office Student Volunteer Agreement – Attachment A

The Civil Service Reform Act of 1978, Public Law 95-454, Section 301 authorizes Federal departments and agencies to accept volunteer service from certain students on behalf of the United State Government. The United States Patent and Trademark Office requires that terms of the volunteer service be agreed upon in writing by appropriate officials of the participating operating unit and the participating educational institution.

This agreement is between the Agency operating unit and the Educational Institution listed below hereinafter referred to as the school.

Agreement	terms are as follows:	
<b>A.</b>	The student is enrolled not less than half time at an accredited school, is recommended by the school and is acceptable to the operating unit.	
В.	The student is being nominated and selected without consideration of race, color, national origin, religion, sex, marital status or handicap.	
C.	. The student's service is non-compensable, will not displace any employee or be used to staff any position that is a normal part of the operating unit's workforce.	
D.	The school will notify the agency contact,, USPTO Office of Human Resources at, if the student terminates his/her enrollment at the school during the period of volunteer service or if the student will have more than five months between school years.	
Е.	The student's work assignment shall be in the public interest, and to the maximum extent possible, shall provide an appropriate educational experience for the student.	
F.	The student is not considered a Federal employee for any purpose other than injury compensation and laws related to the Tort Claims Act.

G. The student is not entitled to benefits, (i.e. leave, retirement, health benefits, travel compensation,

subsistence allowance, quarters, and any other reimbursement or payment in kind).

- I. The operating unit will establish a Personnel Folder for the student that will include; the student's resume, transcript, and other documentation of the work assignment as specified by the U.S. Office of Personnel Management.
- **J.** Evaluations or reports of the student's performance will be provided to the school as requested, subject to regulations governing (1) the protection of privacy in personnel records, and (2) the availability and disclosure of official information.
- **K.** Either the school or the operating unit upon written notice to the other party, may effect termination of the agreement prior to the planned ending date of the volunteer's assignment.
