

PTAB E2E will be replaced by the new AIA Trials portal called P-TACTS. Below is a list of new features and functionalities:

- All P-TACTS users will be required to create a MyUSPTO account to access the system
 - Users will only need one account to access all USPTO applications/systems
- New user role called Staff
- Enhanced petition submission process
 - Ability to pay for Pro Hac Vice (PHV) and submit PHV motion along with petition
- New My Docket functionality for P-TACTS users
 - Ability to view all email notifications received by the user from P-TACTS
- New Case viewer Interface
 - Improved accessibility to access information related to a case
 - New interface provides more detailed information
 - Easy to file documents
- New motions submission workflow
 - Can group motions and their related oppositions, replies and exhibits all together
- Lead and all back-up counsel have the ability to submit documents
- New Joinder functionality
 - Joined cases are grouped for easy access
- Simplified rehearing request submission process
