... faster, cheaper and more efficiently




#### Classification




## Benefits of CPC - coverage

- 4 of 5 major IP Offices classifying in CPC (USPTO engaging JPO on classification cooperation)
- Over 26 countries classifying in CPC





### Benefits of CPC - coverage

#### CPC is international

- Over 50 million worldwide documents in CPC
- One stop shop for most of the world's documents (including some Japanese documents)

#### Benefits of CPC – Asian collection

#### – CPC also has China and Korea prior art.

Classification systems divide the world's knowledge into categories.

USPC and ECLA based on western world view. This can create western bias leading to problems in the classification of knowledge from non-western cultures.

China and Korea provide Asian influence in CPC.

CPC is jointly owned by USPTO and EPO Greater focus on classification harmonization among Offices
