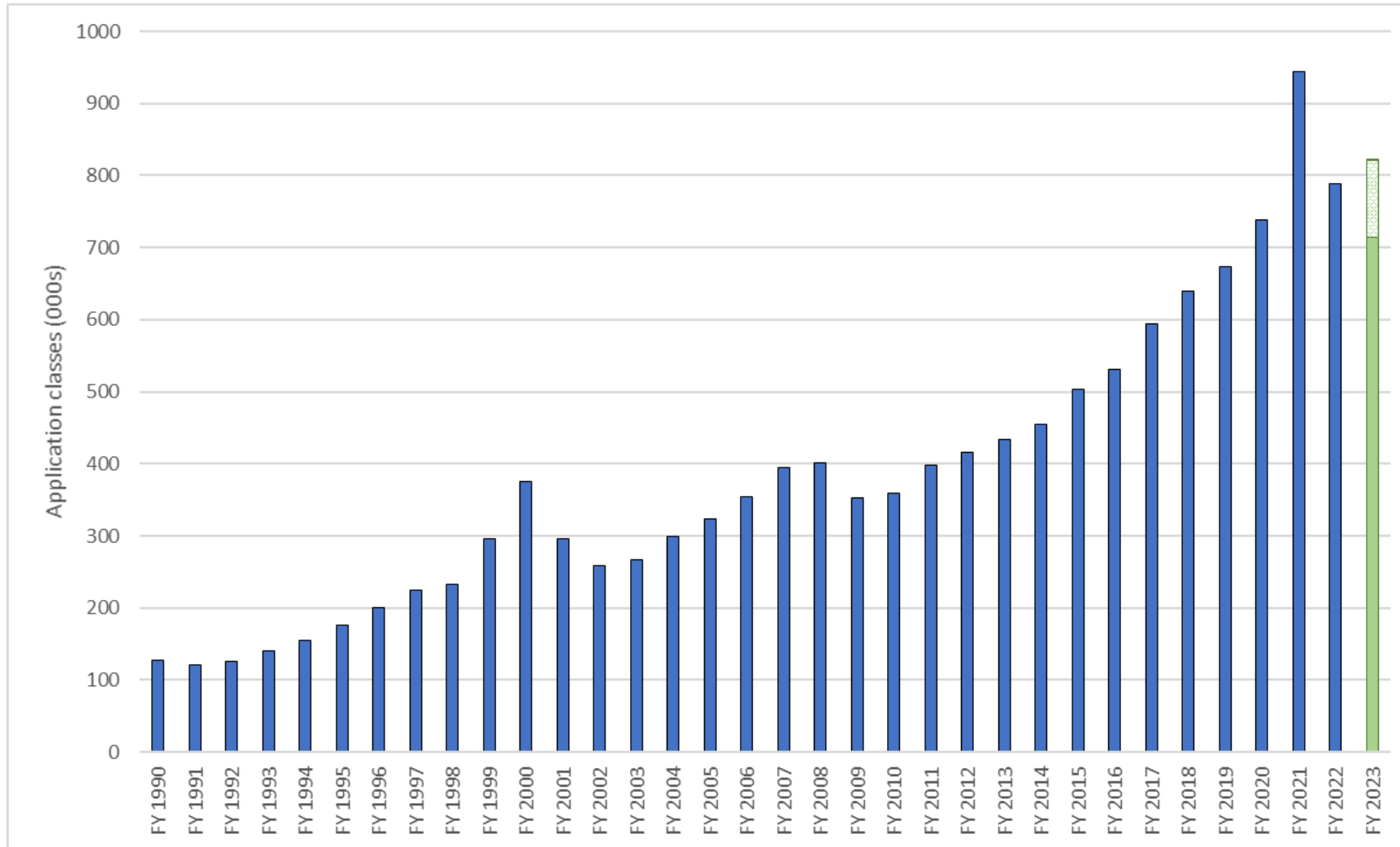

- +27.5%

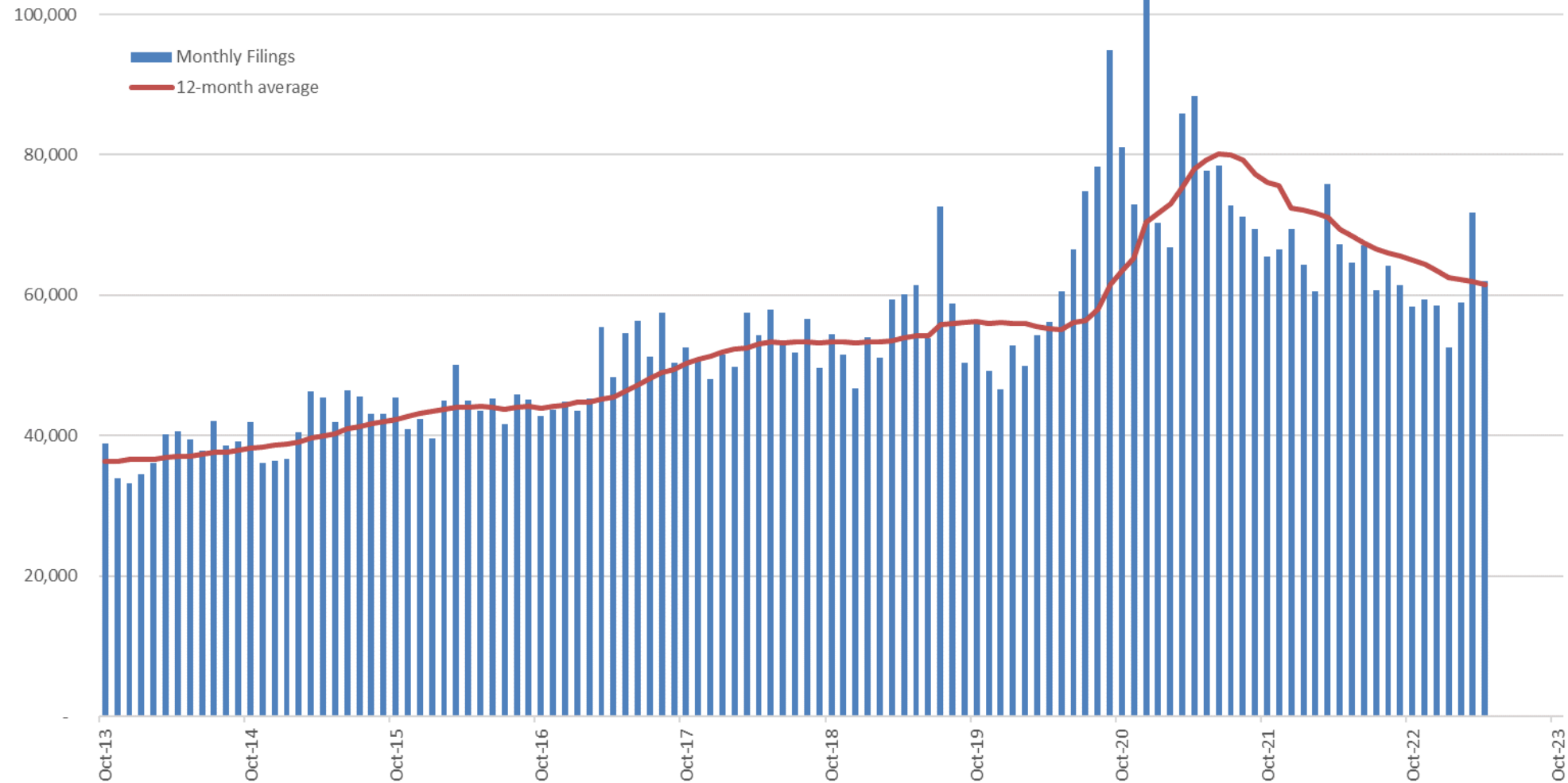
FY 2020

- +9.5%

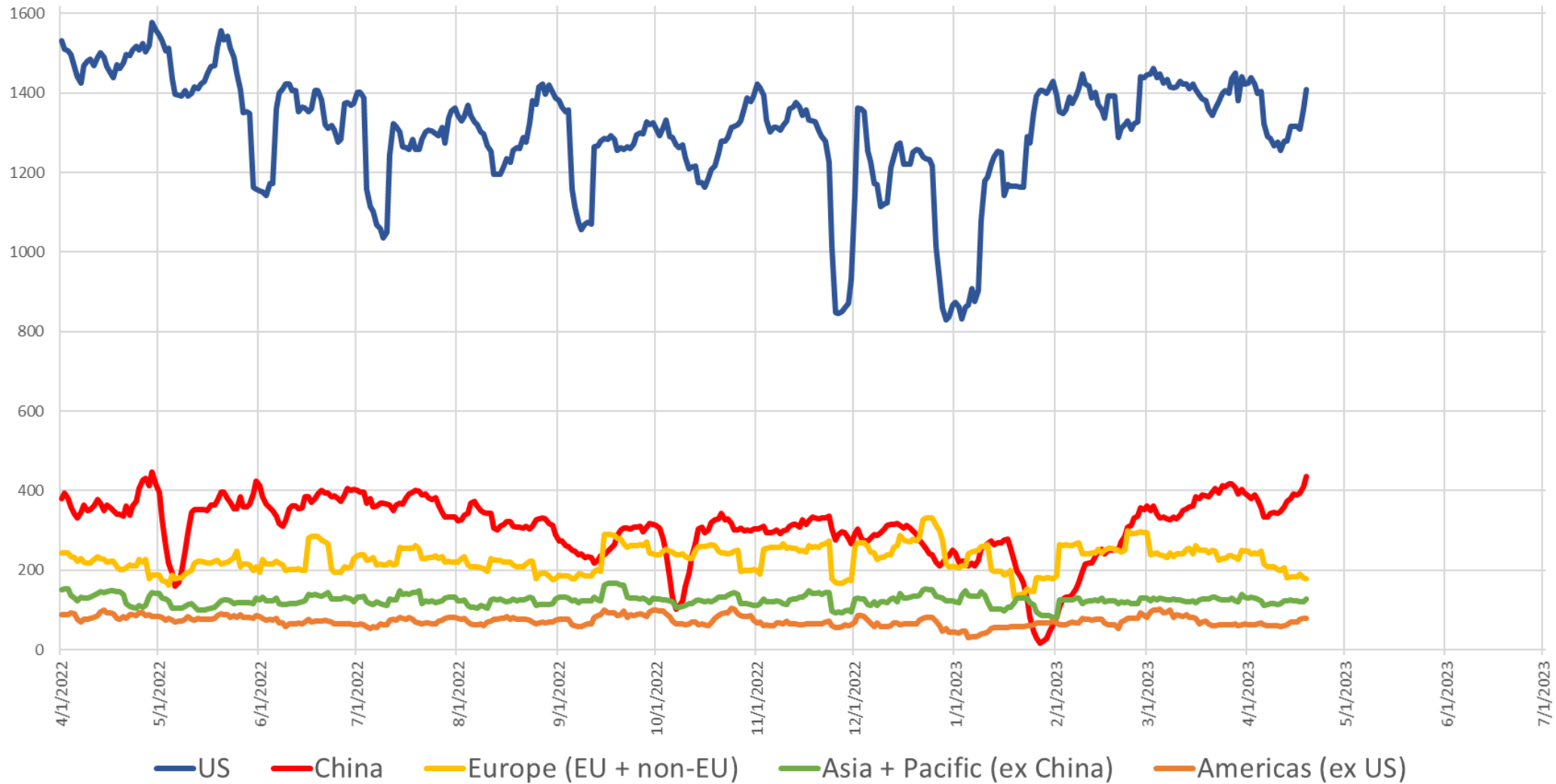
FY 1990 - FY 2021

- CAGR 6.5%

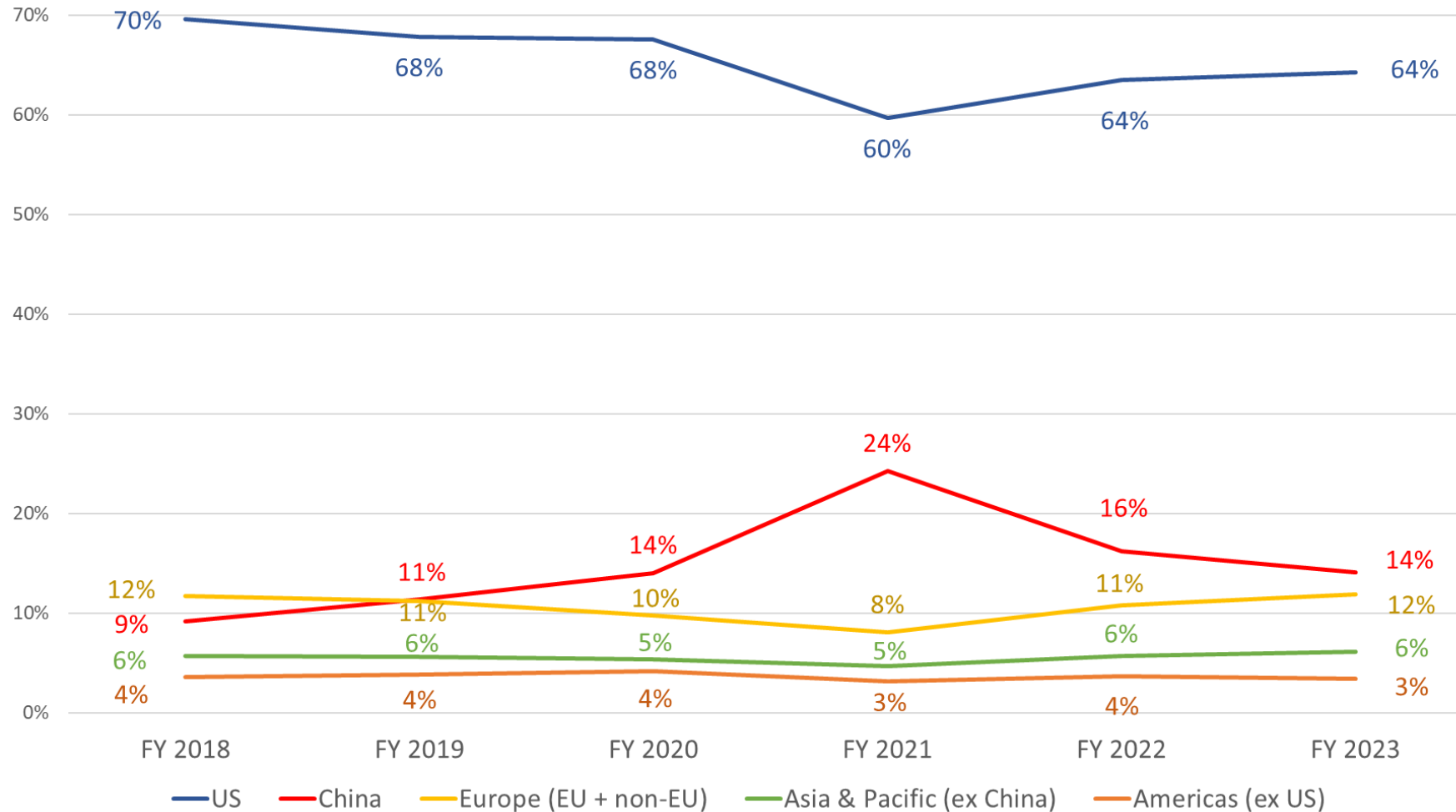
Monthly application filings FY 2014 – 2023



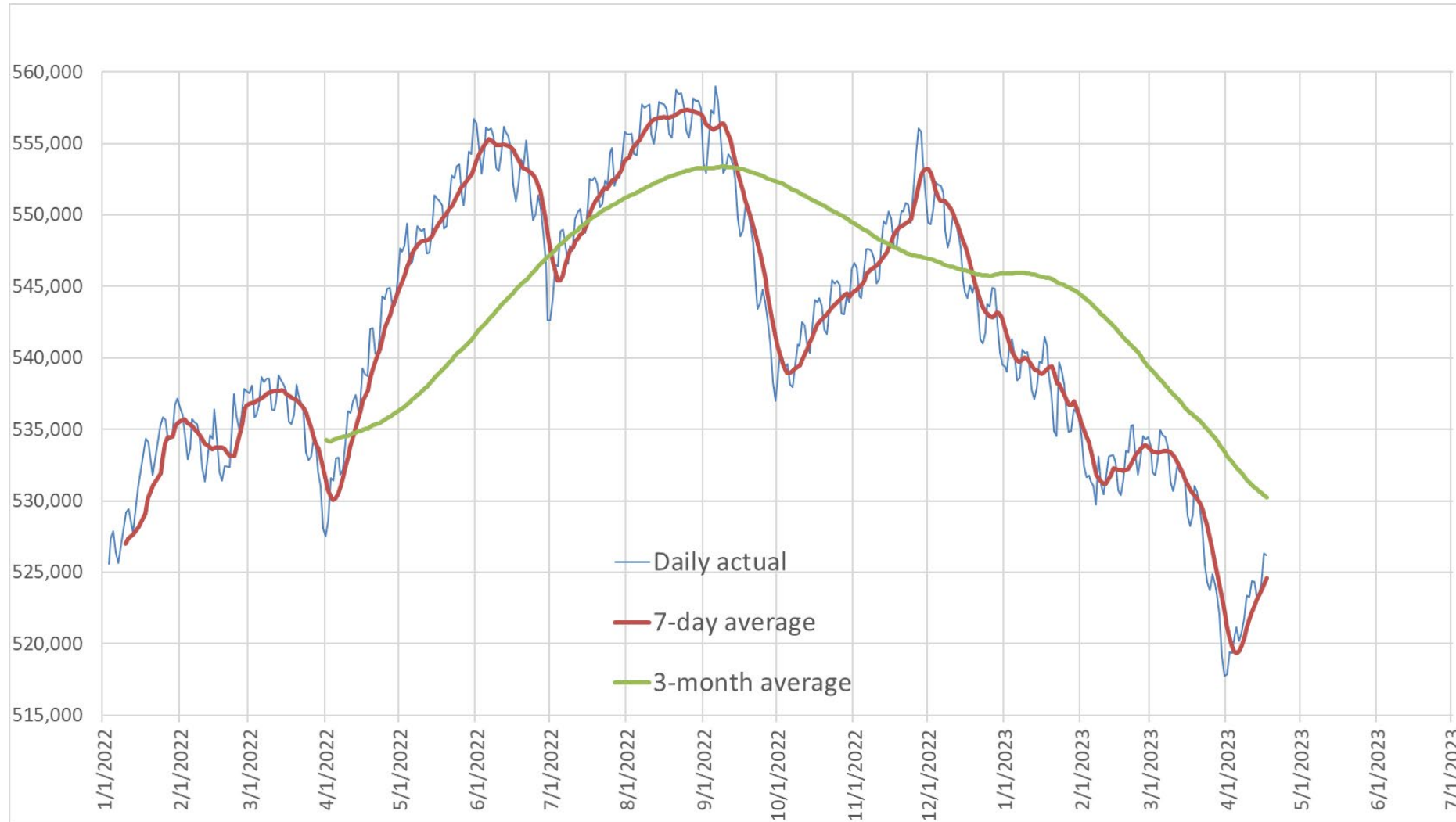
USPTO application origins FY 2022 – 2023



Share of application classes filed by applicant's domicile (FY 2018 – 2023)

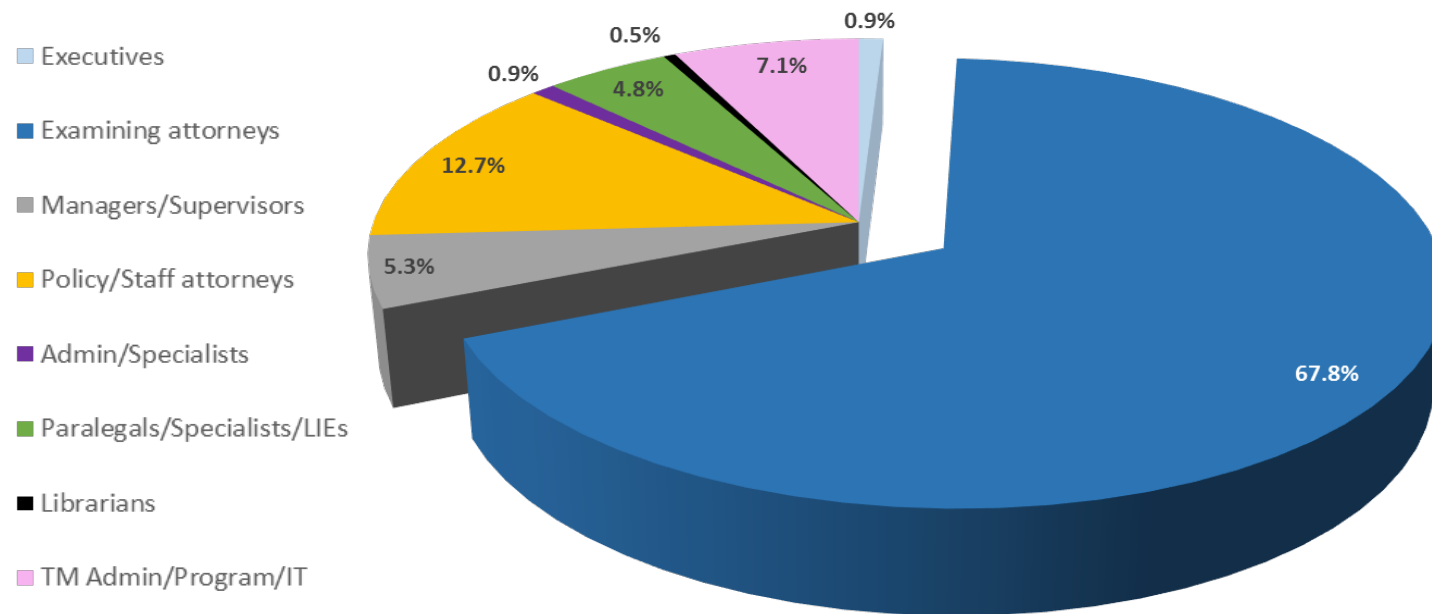


New case inventory since January 2022



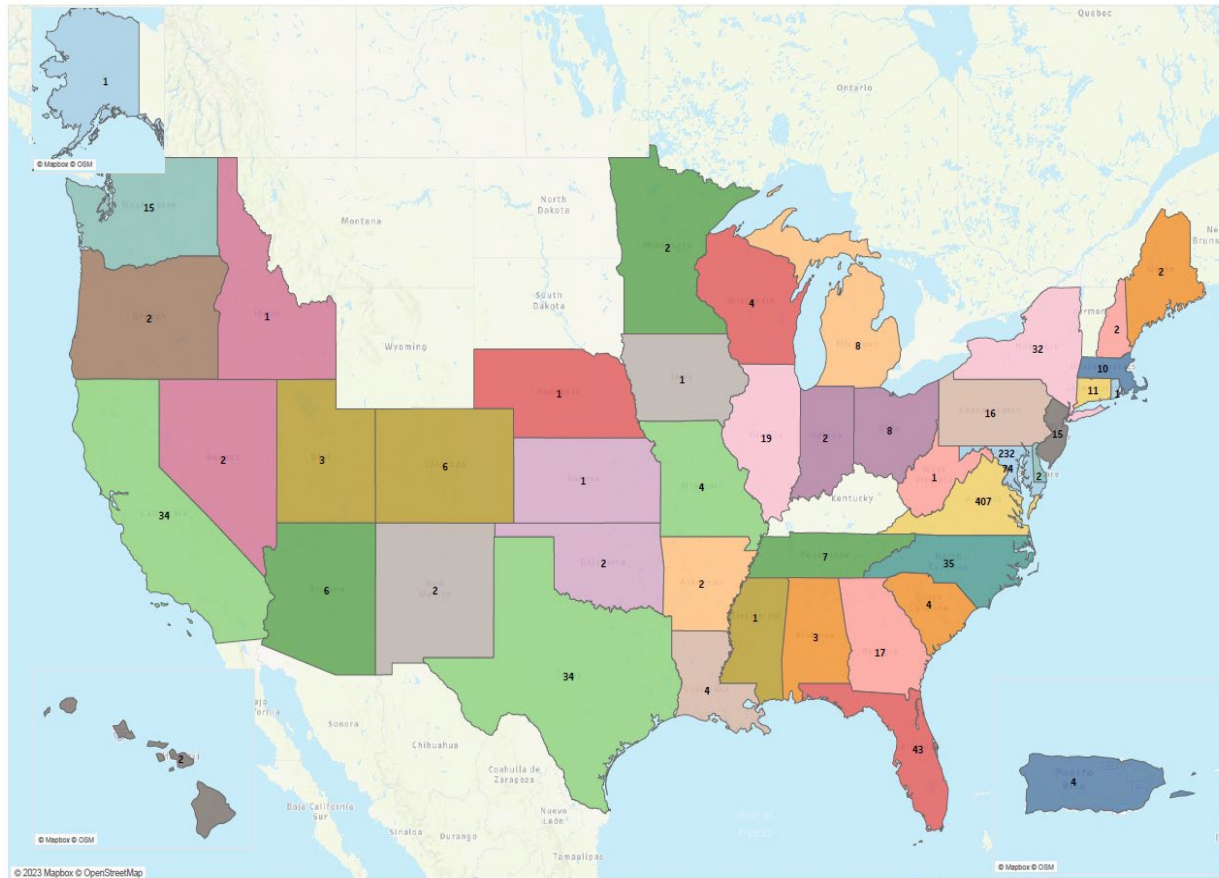
Trademarks staffing

- Nearly 1,100* employees (8.3% of USPTO)
- 736 examining attorneys (67.8% of Trademarks)
 - 93 hires onboarded in FY 2022
 - 90+ hires planned in FY 2023 (46 onboarded in October; 39 began this week)
