G05B17/00	Special Rules of classification	N/A	Documents to be classified in G05B17/00 should be those in which the model of the controlled system is the key concept. For example, creating or adapting the model, and not the control of a system to be controlled, Hardware/Software-in-Loop systems, e.g. connection of a controller to a computer that simulates a machine such as a car, manufacturing machine. G05B13/04 should be used when the key concept stresses or deals with the adaptive part of the control.
