
AIA Roadshow Highlights



- USPTO fee collections continue to normalize

 - February 23, 2012 in Sunnyvale, CA




Genetic Testing Study

- USPTO to report on effective ways to provide "second opinion" genetic diagnostic tests where:
 - gene patents; and
 - exclusive licensing for primary genetic diagnostic tests
- Hearings held where 20 witnesses testified
 - February 16, 2012 @ USPTO: 11 witnesses
 - March 9, 2012 @ San Diego School of Law: 9 witnesses
 - Videos available on AIA micro-site
- Written comments from public due March 26, 2012
- Report due by June 16, 2012




Hiring – Patent Examiners






Hiring — BPAI Administrative Judges





Satellite Offices


- USPTO required to open 3 satellite offices in 3 years

- USPTO screening public comments received in response to a Federal Register Notice seeking input on the locations of the 2 other satellite offices
 - 626 comments received
 - >100 localities recommended




Site Selection Timeline
