

Notice of Petition for Reinstatement

Yi Wan of Guangzhou, China, who is licensed to practice law in the State of New York, and who has been suspended from the representation of others in trademark and other non-patent matters before the United States Patent and Trademark Office (“USPTO”) pursuant to 35 U.S.C. §§ 2(b)(2)(D) and 32, has filed a petition for reinstatement to practice before the USPTO. Granting of reinstatement is subject to, *inter alia*, establishing to the satisfaction of the Director of the Office of Enrollment and Discipline that granting the petition is not contrary to the public interest, and that the suspended practitioner has complied with the provisions of 37 CFR § 11.58 during his period of suspension. 37 CFR § 11.60. Accordingly, information bearing upon the good moral character and reputation of Yi Wan is material to his eligibility for USPTO reinstatement. Any information tending to affect the eligibility of Yi Wan, on moral, ethical or other grounds should be furnished to the Director of the Office of Enrollment and Discipline in a written communication addressed to the Office of Enrollment and Discipline, Mail Stop OED, United States Patent and Trademark Office, P.O. Box 1450, Alexandria, VA 22313-1450, on or before 30 days after the date this notice is published.
