

Notice of Petition for Reinstatement

Mr. Philip T. Virga of Redondo Beach, California, who has been suspended pursuant to 35 U.S.C. §§ 2(b)(2)(D) and 32, has given notice of his intent to file a petition for reinstatement. Granting of reinstatement is subject to, *inter alia*, establishing to the satisfaction of the Director of the Office of Enrollment and Discipline that granting the petition is not contrary to the public interest, and that the suspended practitioner has complied with the provisions of 37 CFR § 11.58 during his period of suspension. 37 CFR § 11.60. Accordingly, information bearing upon the good moral character and reputation of Mr. Virga is material to his eligibility for reinstatement. Any information tending to affect the eligibility of Philip T. Virga on moral, ethical, or other grounds should be furnished to the Director of the Office of Enrollment and Discipline in a written communication addressed to the Office of Enrollment and Discipline, Mail Stop OED, United States Patent and Trademark Office, P.O. Box 1450, Alexandria, VA 22313-1450, on or before December 7, 2020.
