- USPTO proposal to provide all stakeholders secure, one-stop access to dossier and examination information of all family applications
- Quickly adopted -- first by JPO, followed by the remaining IP5 Offices and WIPO
- Realigns and streamlines a multitude of IT efforts such as IP5 One Portal Dossier, WIPO CASE, ePCT



- New "Stakeholder" attitude among IPOs
 - The system is now global
 - Discussions have taken on a new, allencompassing, user-centric focus
 - Focus on promoting innovation and job growth



- New look at work streams
 - One portal management of cross-filed applications
 - Reduce duplication
 - Increase efficiencies
 - Prevent inadvertent loss of rights



- Global Dossier is now an initiative under the IP5 framework with WIPO on board as full partner
- Task Force for gathering user requirements forming with participants from:
 - IP5 Offices
 - WIPO
 - IP5 Industry
- Task Force is responsible for reaching out to all stakeholders
- Technical analyses under way at IP5 Offices to determine how IT projects align with and lead to the Global Dossier
