Future Offices

- The Satellite Office Selection Team has one primary goal:
 - To provide highly objective recommendations to the Under Secretary and Deputy Under Secretary on the best locations for two USPTO Satellite Offices.



Criteria—Top Level

- The criteria the team will use focuses on those outlined by Congress in the *America Invents Act* including:
 - Applicant Outreach
 - Recruitment
 - Retention
 - Economic Impact on the Community
 - Geographic Diversity
- Stated goals of backlog reduction and improved quality captured in submeasures related to the above categories
- Additionally, the team will consider operational cost to the Agency in making its recommendation.



Timeline

- September 2011—Team Selected to Methodology Development
- November 29, 2012—Federal Register Notice Published
- November 2011 – January 2012, Methodology Developed
- January 31, 2012—Notice and Comment period closes (over 500 comments received)
- February 2012—Contract to Clean and Baseline Data awarded
- March 2012—Team begins analysis
- May 2012—Team Recommendation to Management
