## 113<sup>th</sup> Congress (Active IP Legislation)

#### IP Legislation Highlights (addressing substantive IP issues/Access):

- Software Patents, H.R. 845, "Saving High-Tech Innovators from Egregious Legal Disputes" (SHIELD) Act of 2013 (Rep. Defazio, D-OR-04) introduced: 2/27/2013
- Foreign Counterfeit Merchandise Prevention Act, **H.R. 22** (Rep. Poe, R-TX-02) introduced: 1/3/2013
- Seed Availability and Competition Act of 2013, H.R. 193 (Rep. Kaptur, D-OH-15) introduced: 1/4/2013
- Preserve Access to Affordable Generics Act, S.214 (Klobachar, D-MN) introduced:
- Fair Access to Science and Technology Research Act of 2013
  - H.R.708 (Doyle, D-PA-14) introduced: 2/14/2013
  - S. 350 (Cornyn, R-OK) introduced: 2/14/2013
- Cyber Security
  - ♣ H.R.624 (Rogers, R-MI-08) introduced: 2/13/2013

# 113<sup>th</sup> Congress (Active IP Legislation)

IP Legislation Highlights (affecting Funding and Employee Pay Issues):

- Eliminate 2013 pay adjustment for federal employees, H.R. 273 (Rep. DeSantis, R-FL-06) introduced: 1/14/2013
  - Passed House 2/15/2013, 261-154
- FY 2013 Appropriations CR through March 27, 2013
  H.R. 933 Full Year CR; Passed House 3/6/2013, 267-151
- Senate mark filed 3/11/2013



# 113<sup>th</sup> Congress (Draft Legislation)

#### Drafts Legislation discussed:

- Aaron's Law Computer Fraud and Abuse Act (draft)
  - Sen. Wyden, Rep. Lofgren and others have considered draft in reaction to the death of Aaron Swartz, Internet activist
  - Solution House may consider changes, in particular to the level of penalties

#### Online Copyright Protection

- Solution Various proposals discussed during the 112<sup>th</sup> Congress may resurface; opposition likely
- Protecting American Trade Secrets and Innovation Act of 2012 (112<sup>th</sup> Congress)
  - expected to be introduced by Sen. Coons (D-DE)
  - Bill would create a federal civil private right of action for trade secret theft

- FY 2014 Appropriations possibly Spring 2013 House Appropriations, Subcommittee on Commerce, Justice and Science
- USPTO Oversight possibly Spring 2013 House Judiciary Committee
- Online Copyright Protection related Spring 2013 House Judiciary Committee and possibly Senate Judiciary
