

- Current Patent Quality Composite Measure was implemented in FY 2010
  - Consists of seven individual measures, including work product reviews, surveys and statistical data
- Strategic Plan timeframe for current Patent Quality Composite ends in 2015
- Joint USPTO- PPAC team is revisiting the Patent Quality Composite
  - Can it be revised to better reflect current USPTO goals and priorities and meet stakeholder needs?
  - Will gather stakeholder input and incorporate into any revisions







- Considerations for the selection of quality indicators:
  - Balanced
  - Objective
  - Allow for timely analysis and feedback
  - Flexible
  - Easily understood
  - Enhance public confidence



#### Action items:

- On-going meetings with USPTO-PPAC Quality Team
- Revise measures
- Publish proposed metric with Request for Comments in Federal Register and Official Gazette
- Finalize measures, incorporating stakeholder input
- Implement measures
- Outreach/education to external and internal stakeholders
