I am generally in favor of Proposal 6 and I might use it. However, I would likely not be able to use it much because it would allow for only a single interview unless I happened to have multiple applications with the same examiner and all of those clients wanted interviews at the same time—which is a highly unusual occurrence. Since I do not live near Alexandria, I have to travel to have in-person interviews and I try to have 5-7 interviews with multiple examiners in different art units over a couple of days.

A proposal that might have a nominal fee to bring hotelling examiners to the PTO in VA would be better—something to defray the travel cost (like \$400-\$500). In an alternative, I would be willing to have a hotelling examiner webEx to an interview I held in person with the SPE in VA for no cost. However, Track 1 in-person interviews I don't think should have a cost associated with them (because there's already a hefty fee associated with Track 1 cases).
