There should be a review of quality based on reversal on appeal. If the Examiner gets reversed, or repeatedly reversed, that should be a negative.

Examiners have no disincentive to reject, under the current system, and every incentive to reject. If they reject everything, then they never make a "mistake" in any patent (there are no patents).

This is the biggest flaw in the current system. Examiners stand on their rejections, and applicants have to appeal and wait several years for a reversal.
