

 - Quality issues
- CRIMINAL
 - Local PSB (Police)
 - Prosecutor Court







When available?

• CIVIL

ALL trademark infringement cases

• ADMINISTRATIVE

- Straightforward cases
- Not only trademark infringement

CRIMINAL

- Same mark on same goods
- Threshold: turnover > US\$7.5k or revenue > US\$4.5k




Know Beyond the Law: Things Not Written in the Law






Number of Civil Cases

Administrative Cases are Decreasing!

- Seller's defense for legitimate source after 2013
- Usually limited to straightforward cases
- Higher uncertainty
- No compensation (compared with increased compensation you can get from Court)

Qiang Gu Case (Beijing IP Court) First Instance: RMB10 Million (US\$1.5 Million) The highest damages awarded by Beijing IP Court in TM infringement case so far.

New Balance Case (Guangdong High Court) First Instance: RMB 98 Million (US\$14.5 Million) Second Instance: RMB 5 Million (US\$0.75 Million)

Why Choose Criminal?

Pros:


Powerful


