The Patents Ombudsman Program provides assistance to applicants and attorneys throughout the application process including initial filing, patent examination, and post examination and specializes in facilitation when an application becomes stalled in the examination process. Ms. Downs manages incoming customer concerns, tracks and performs trend analysis of those concerns to identify patent examination training needs, and coordinates outreach programs to educate external customers on how to better utilize the program.

Before joining the Patents Ombudsman Program, Ms. Downs worked as a Patent Appeals Specialist in the Patent Appeals Center (PAC).
