

Notice of Petition for Reinstatement and Opportunity for Public Comment

Mr. Mark A. Levenda of Mesa Arizona, is a registered patent agent (USPTO Reg. No. 57413) whose address is 3413 N. Saffron, Mesa, AZ 85215. On February 27, 2018, the Director of the United States Patent and Trademark Office ("USPTO" or "Office") accepted Mr. Levenda's affidavit of resignation and ordered his exclusion on consent from practice before the Office in patent, trademark, and non-patent law.

Mr. Levenda acknowledged that the OED Director was of the opinion that his conduct violated 37 C.F.R. §§ 11.102(a), 11.104, 11.105(b), 11.107(a), 11.108(f), 11.116, 11.504(a), 11.504(c), 11.804(d), and 11.804(i). *See In re Levenda*, Proceeding No. D2018-21 (USPTO February 27, 2018), which is posted for public reading at the Office of Enrollment and Discipline Reading Room accessible at: <https://foiadocuments.uspto.gov/oed/>. In summary, the exclusion on consent and violations were predicated on Mr. Levenda's acceptance of referrals of clients in patent matters from Desa Industries, Inc., a New York business corporation that did business as World Patent Marketing in Miami Beach, Florida. At the time Mr. Levenda accepted the referrals, World Patent Marketing was not a law firm nor was it otherwise authorized to offer or provide legal services.

Mr. Levenda has filed his petition for reinstatement to practice before the USPTO. A suspended or excluded practitioner may not be reinstated unless it is established to the satisfaction of the OED Director that reinstatement is not contrary to the public interest, and that the suspended or excluded practitioner has complied with the provisions of 37 C.F.R. § 11.58 during his period of suspension or exclusion. *See* 37 C.F.R. § 11.60.

USPTO reinstatement proceedings for suspended or excluded practitioners are open to the public. Before reinstating any excluded or suspended practitioner, the OED Director shall publish a notice that such practitioner seeks reinstatement and shall permit the public a reasonable opportunity to comment or submit evidence regarding such matter. *See* 37 C.F.R. § 11.60(h)(1).

Therefore, pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 11.60(h)(1), the public is invited to submit any comment, evidence, or other information tending to affect the eligibility for reinstatement of Mr. Mark A. Levenda, on moral, ethical, or other grounds to the OED Director via written communication addressed to the Office of Enrollment and Discipline, Mail Stop OED, United States Patent and Trademark Office, P.O. Box 1450, Alexandria, VA 22313-1450 or via email to [OED@uspto.gov](mailto:OED@uspto.gov) (please enter "Public Comment" in the subject line) preferably on or before thirty (30) days after the date this notice is published.
