

# Trademark Information Network:

# Critical application issues after you file

- Registration is not instantaneous or guaranteed.
  - Your application will be reviewed.
  - It may be refused or need corrections.
  - You may be required to pay additional fees.
- Use the electronic resources provided by the USPTO.
  - Check your application status on the [Trademark Status and Document Retrieval](#) system (TSDR).
  - View, download, and print documents through TSDR.
- Check your application status every three or four months.
  - If you do not respond to USPTO correspondence, your application may be abandoned.
  - If your contact information changes, update it through the [Change Address or Representation form](#).
- If you have questions, ask.

  - The USPTO does not require representation by an attorney, unless you are [foreign-domiciled](#).
