Subject: Comments on Proposed Rulemaking - RIN 0651-AD25

Dear Sir or Madam,

On January 19, 2018, the USPTO published a proposal in the Federal Register (83 Fed. Reg. 2759) to eliminate four unnecessary regulations. While I am affiliated with Emerson Thomson Bennett, LLC, these comments represent my personal views.

I generally support the proposed removal of these regulations because they are unnecessary and because removing them will reduce the number of rules a person will need to review to ensure compliance.

My support for removing §1.351 is mainly because the USPTO's proposal indicates that the Administrative Procedures Act and OMB guidance already require amendments to 37 CFR Part 1 to be published in the Federal Register. The advance notice of regulatory changes by publication in the Federal Register is important in letting interested parties of the change.
