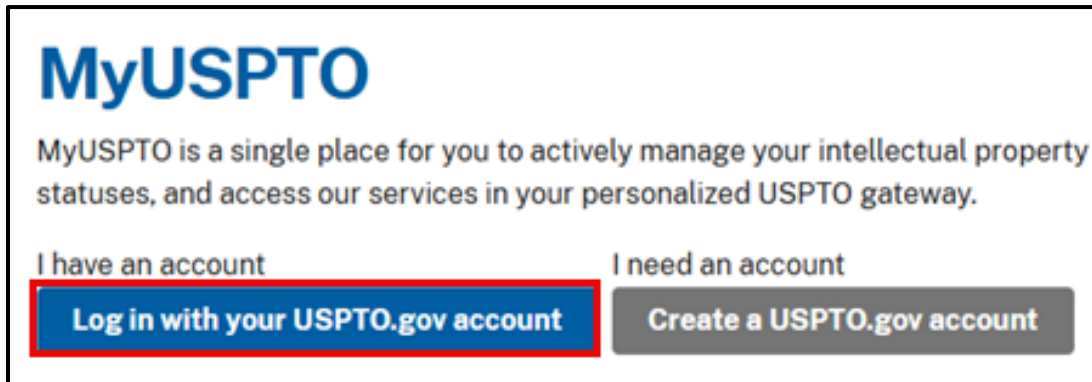
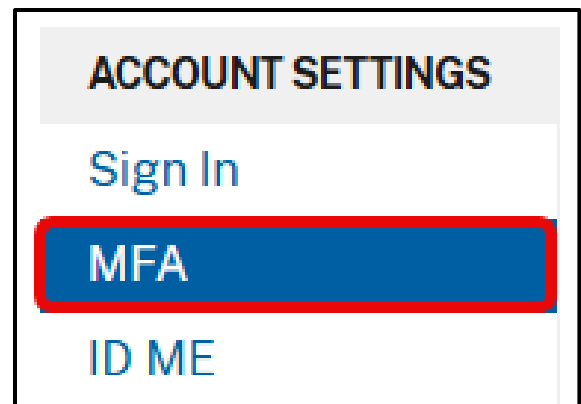
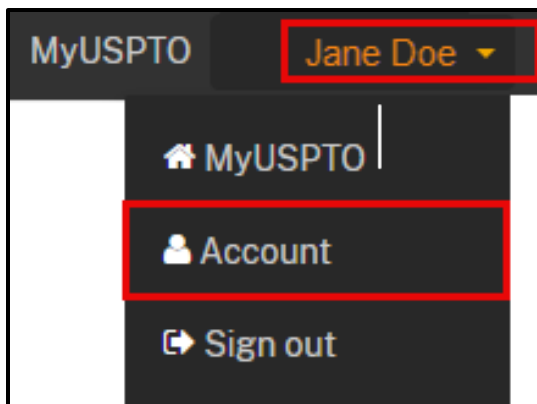


# **Authenticator Application Setup for Windows Desktop**

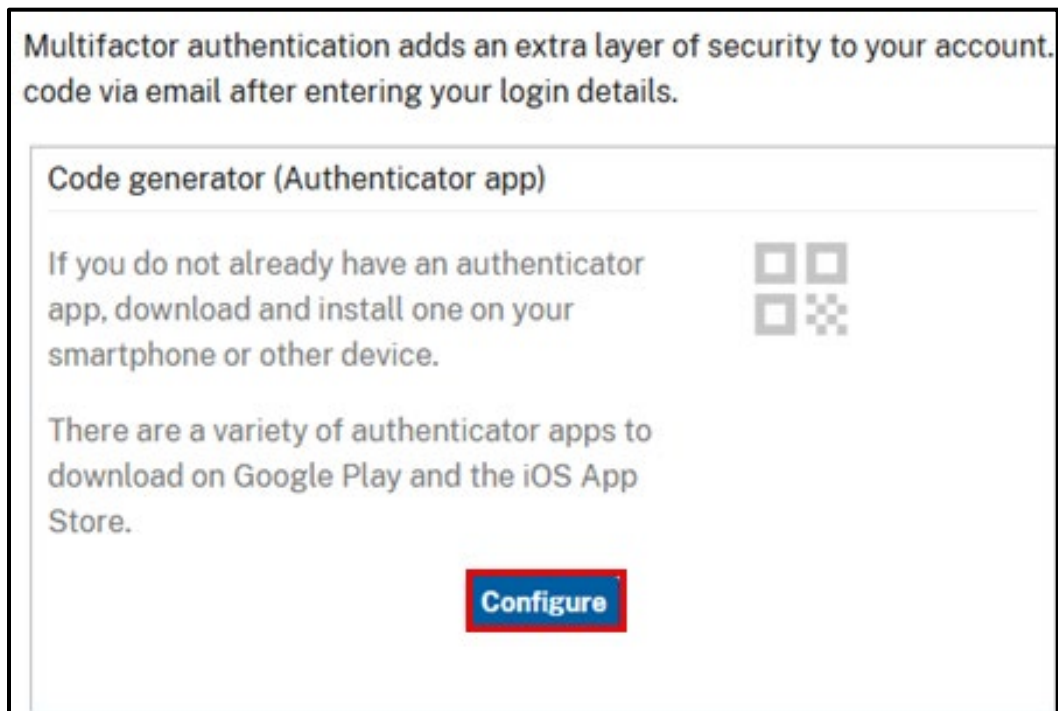
- 1 **Clear your web browser's cache.** Go to <https://myuspto.gov> and click the link to select **Log-in with your USPTO.gov account**.



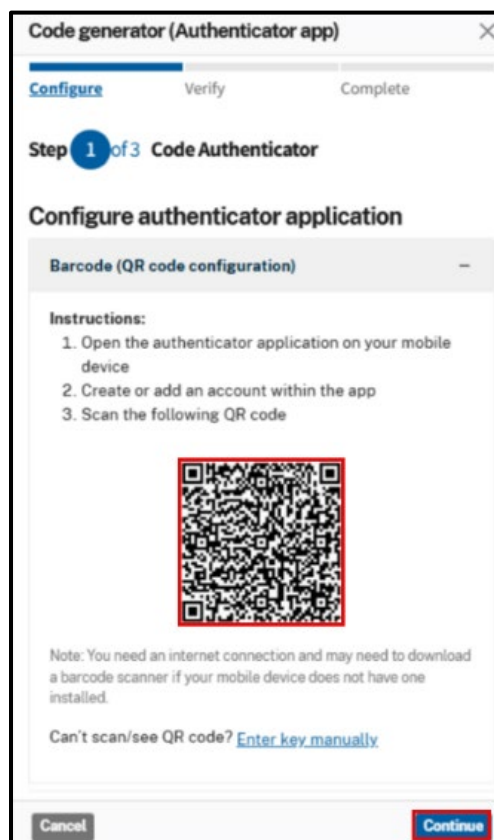
- 2 In the top-right corner, click the drop-down arrow next to your name and select **Account**. From the left menu, under **Account Settings**, click **MFA**.



- 3** To setup **Multifactor authentication** click **Configure**.

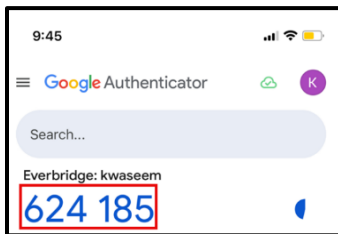


- 4** From your mobile phone, scan the **QR code** and click **Continue**.




- 5 Enter the authentication codes from your authenticator app (Google, Microsoft, Authy, etc.) and click **Complete**.

Type the **passcode** in the **First authentication field**.

Wait 30 seconds and type the **refreshed passcode** in the **Second authentication field**.

Enter the two consecutive six digit authentication codes. Authentication codes change after 30 seconds.


