

PTAB hearing rooms: Remote offices

San Jose, California

- Maximum occupancy is 10
- Overflow facilities available



Denver, Colorado

- Maximum occupancy is 70
- Overflow facilities available



PTAB hearing rooms: Remote offices

Detroit, Michigan

- Maximum occupancy is 14
- Overflow facilities available



Dallas, Texas

- Maximum occupancy is 13
- Overflow facilities available




Madison Building: Atrium (inside)








PTAB hearing rooms: Alexandria









PTAB hearing rooms: Alexandria

- Hearing Room A: maximum capacity is 63 occupants.
- Hearing Room B: maximum capacity is 15 occupants.
- Hearing Room D: maximum capacity is 28 occupants.
- Headquarters does not have designated overflow facilities.

PTAB hearing rooms: Capabilities

- Monitors outside of each hearing room to identify case information
- Digital timer
- Multiple displays for remote participants and demonstratives
- Multiple cameras for output options





PTAB hearing rooms: Capabilities


- Document camera (ELMO)
- Annotation touch screen at the podium





Remote viewing


- Schedule posted at <u>www.uspto.gov/patents/ptab/hearings</u>
- Submit request to PTABHearings@uspto.gov at least 3 days before the hearing.






Hearing room protocol/decorum

- Formal business attire, or business casual attire if you are an observer
- Guidelines
 - No recording devices
 - Turn off cell phones and electronic devices
 - No food or drink, except water
 - Unless the APJ permits, there will be no entries/exits from the hearing rooms
 - During the hearing, excessive talking or loud outbursts are prohibited
 - Improper hearing room behavior may result in removal or other sanctions

Virtual hearings

- PTAB uses WebEx virtual platform
- Counsel must check in before the hearing to confirm sound level and quality
 - Technical issues may occur, so allow some time
 - Hearings staff will contact counsel and provide a link
- After sound check, you will be placed in a party holding room
- Lead counsel must also be on the line, even if not arguing (see Consolidated Trial Practice Guide)
- Hearing begins when everyone on the line is ready and then the party holding room is joined with the panel holding room
- Judges will have access to entire record and demonstratives

Legal Experience and Advancement Program (LEAP)

- Open to practitioner with three or fewer substantive arguments in any federal tribunal
- Can conduct the entire hearing or share time
- More experienced practitioner may assist or clarify points if necessary
- Typically 15 minutes of additional time granted for hearing
- Request must be made in advance
- Available for ex parte appeals and AIA trials



In-person hearings by location


March 2023 - February 2024





In-person vs remote appearance for appeals


March 2023 – February 2024

March 2023 – February 2024






Public video access to hearings March 2023 – February 2024

 - 123 AIA trials
 - 37 ex parte appeals
