





TIP #2:

Address examiner's responses to your arguments.





TIP #3:

Get on the record why you are right.





TIP #4:

Make your best case while being true to the record.





TIP #5:

Make all your arguments in the Appeal Brief instead of "saving" them for the Reply Brief.
