Subject: Please consider San Diego, CA as a location for a USPTO satellite office location

To Whom it May Concern,
Please include San Diego in your locations for consideration for the location of a new satellite office for the USPTO. Locating an office in California is a prudent move based upon the diversity of innovation in the state and the population density. Locating an office in San Diego in particular would be advantageous in that San Diego:

- 1) is a metropolitan area with the amenities of easy access for visitors via rail, car, and air (and optionally sea);
- 2) has less traffic than the San Francisco Bay Area (including Silicon Valley) or Los Angeles;
- 3) is a location where many people, including potential office employees would like to live;
- 4) is a location where the population is sufficiently qualified to recruit examiners from;
- 5) is the location of numerous military facilities which provides for the safety of the office in times of emergency and also may provide a population from which to draw examiners with security clearances, if needed; and
- 6) is an area where there are continuing advancements in biotech, environmental science, aerospace technologies, electrical engineering, civil engineering, clean-tech, computer science, recreational equipment, and many other fields, and so would be located near many inventors.
