Hello,

My name is Gordon Baldwin and I am a Primary Patent Examiner at the USPTO. My suggestion for another satellite location of the USPTO is Atlanta, Georgia. Atlanta has many things going for it.

Atlanta is a hub for technology in the southeast with major research institutions such as Georgia Tech, University of Georgia, Clemson, University of South Carolina, Alabama, Auburn, Vanderbilt, University of Tennessee and the University of Alabama within approximately 250 miles. These schools are graduating significant numbers of engineering and chemical students every year.

The housing prices in Atlanta are very reasonable compared to the Washington, D.C. metropolitan area.

Atlanta's Hartsfield International Airport is the busiest airport in the world and would provide easy commuting to Washington D.C. due to the amount of flights flown daily between the two cities. Also the flight is generally only 1.5 hours long between the two cities.

These are but of few of the many examples of why I think the USPTO should consider Atlanta, Georgia.
