I am writing to encourage you to consider Albuquerque, NM as a satellite office for the US Patent and Trademark Office. Albuquerque meets all of the criteria published: having access to Universities with strong engineering programs, many attorneys and agents in the region and significant public transportation infrastructure. All parts of the city are easily accessible to a major international airport. There are other numerous governmental operations presently in Albuquerque, not the least of which is the regional HQ for the Forest Service and easy access to two national laboratories for additional expertise: Sandia National Laboratory and Los Alamos National Laboratory. Albuquerque also has a reasonable cost of living and lower than the national average unemployment. For this reason I believe Albuquerque would fill the requirement to help recruit and retain a highly skilled workforce, reduce patent application pendency and improve quality and enhance communication between the USPTO and the patent applicant community.
