MPEP IdeaScale received the following comment from Michael D. Berger:

The America Invents Act was signed into law on Friday. This opens the "Micro-Entity" as an option for 75% reduced fees. I believe the USPTO should provide an overall 75% off for micro-entities until they are able to promulgate new rules for micro-entity fees. As it currently stands, Micro-entities will be subject to the 15% surcharge as will all entities. This is not what was intended with the new rules and needs to be corrected before the surcharge takes effect.
