

This communication is being sent to all the member countries of the Paris Union, including those which are not yet bound by the Lisbon or Stockholm Acts. It is understood that only countries bound by the latter Acts are bound, under the Paris Convention itself (Article 6ter(1)(b) and (3)(b)), to afford protection to armorial bearings, flags and other emblems, abbreviations and names of intergovernmental organizations. However, other member countries of the Paris Union may be in a position, in this particular case, to afford the same protection, or may be willing to do so, in accordance with their national legislation and independently of any treaty obligation.

The Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) presents his compliments to the Minister for Foreign Affairs and has the honor to send him herewith, at the request of the Commission of the European Communities and pursuant to Article 6ter(3)(b) of the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, as revised at Lisbon on October 14, 1958 (Lisbon Act), and at Stockholm on July 14, 1967 (Stockholm Act):

- (i) the name and abbreviated name in Danish, English and Irish of the European Atomic Energy Community (see Annex I); the name and abbreviated name in Dutch, French, German and Italian were the subject of Circular No. 447-1 of December 17, 1963, and recapitulatory circular No. 645-551 of December 5, 1966;
- (ii) the name and abbreviated name in Danish, Dutch, English, French, German, Irish and Italian of the European Economic Community (see Annex II);
- (iii) the name and abbreviated name in Danish, Dutch, English, French, German, Irish and Italian of the European Coal and Steel Community (see Annex III);
- (iv) the emblem adopted by the Commission of the European Communities (see Annex IV).
