Since you have passed the examination, you are hereby given limited recognition pursuant to 37 CFR § 10.9(a) to prepare and prosecute patent applications before the Patent and Trademark Office. Although you have been given limited recognition, you may not hold yourself out as a registered patent attorney or patent agent until the Office of Enrollment and Discipline has given your application final approval. Your limited recognition may be subject to the provisions of 37 CFR § 10.10(b) and 18 U.S.C. § 207. During the period of limited recognition, your name will be published in the *Official Gazette* and information tending to affect your eligibility on moral and ethical grounds will be solicited.

Your provisional registration number is P- You must use the provisional number until you receive a letter from the Office of Enrollment and Discipline indicating that your registration application has received final approval. This number must appear below your signature on every paper submitted to the Patent and Trademark Office.

After your application has been given final approval by the Office of Enrollment and Discipline, your certificate of registration will be forwarded to you at the business address on your data sheet filed with this office. The date which appears on the certificate of registration will be the date of your registration.
