Opinion by Hairston, Administrative Trademark Judge:

On October 26, 1998 respondent, Nader Angha, filed a
request that the Board modify the decision issued herein on
September 23, 1998. In particular, respondent states that
the Board improperly characterized its licensee, Maktab
Tarighe Oveyssi Shah Maghsoudi, as a predecessor.

Respondent requests that where the word "predecessor"
appears in the decision, it be changed to "Maktab Tarighe
Oveyssi Shah Maghsoudi."

Cancellation No. 24,510

Under the circumstances, respondent's request is granted and the Board's decision is hereby amended as follows:

On page 3, at lines 13 and 14: "Maktab Tarighe Oveyssi Shah Maghsoudi" is hereby substituted for "another predecessor;"

On page 3, at lines 27 and 28: "Maktab Tarighe Oveyssi Shah Maghsoudi" is hereby substituted for "one of his predecessors;" and

On page 4, at lines 2 and 3: "Maktab Tarighe Oveyssi Shah Maghsoudi" is hereby substituted for "the predecessor organization."
