Comment to Office Plan To Cease Supplying Copies of Cited US Patents

The USPTO can achieve its purpose in a far easier method with sufficient security. When mailing back an office action the USPTO could give the applicant a 10 digit alpha-numeric password. There are over 2,000,000,000,000,000 passwords available assuming that the password is not case sensitive. The applicant could then simply go to the USPTO WEB cite, put in their application serial number and their 10 digit password and then download the cited patents.

If the above solution is unacceptable to the applicant, the applicant upon filing of the application could specify to make the references available on PAIRS only. After application publication the password could be made public for anyone do download at their leisure.
