In B63C 9/00 and subgroups, the sole purpose of the device is to provide enough flotation for people - under distress – to stay afloat. It is designed with the capacity to maintain a person afloat.

On the other hand, A63B 31/00 relates to swimming aids, i.e. devices which do not necessarily provide a flotation capacity sufficient to maintain a person afloat and are intended to help swimming. "Swimming" needs to be understood as an active movement by the user and not simply staying afloat.

There are inevitably overlaps, so double classification might be needed.
