- three structural layers: cover (exclusively), intermediate layer (all the intermediate layers: Inner Cover, Mantel, Outer Core) and core (exclusively), respectively;
- ball as a whole.

The following "branches" apply independently to each of the different structural layers (cover, intermediate layer, core) and are repeated for each of the structural layers:

- · Materials and Chemistry
- · Coefficient of restitution
- Hardness
- · Hardness Gradient
- Thickness / Diameter
- · Deflection or Compression
- Density / Gravity
- · Melt flow rate
- Mass, Weight (only common to the core and to the ball as a whole)
- Initial Velocity (only common to the core and to the ball as a whole)
- Flexural Modulus

(Note that some properties are not repeated for each structural layer and have therefore not been mentioned here).

It will be often necessary to classify the chemistry aspects outside of the scope of <u>A63B</u>. Thus, multiple classification is commonly used between classes and sections. Some guidance can be derived from the following examples:

The best approach for classifying golf ball documents:

Look through the abstract;

Look at the drawings;

Look through the claims;

Look through the description:

- Pay attention to the first paragraph, "Summary of the invention";
- In the "Detailed description of this invention" pay attention wherever it is written "...of this invention" (and similar);
- Depending on the main invention, some information from the description can be considered significant or not, that is to say, to be classified as "Invention Information" or "Additional Information". For classifying "Additional Information" pay attention to the different embodiments, examples and tables;
- Sometimes the examples compare the invention with another golf ball, which is usually not to be classified.
- Common general knowledge present in the Description should not be classified.

The physical properties of subassemblies encompassing simultaneously different layers of a golf ball are to be classified as properties of the golf ball as a whole; e.g. the "compression of a golf ball subassembly consisting of the center and the intermediate layer has a compression of 50 or less" is classified as A63B 37/0087.

"Volume" and/or "surface" of the core or a layer of a golf ball must be classified with the equivalent physical property of diameter or thickness of the corresponding layer.

#### Glossary of terms

In this place, the following terms or expressions are used with the meaning indicated:

The issue of the different layers of the ball:


- · Non-structural: Coating/Marking.
- Structural: Cover, Intermediate layer, Core.

Golf balls usually have only ONE cover and only ONE core. The rest of the structural layers are simply intermediate layers.

- Irrespective of the wording and leaving aside the Coating/Markings (if any):
- Cover the outermost mechanical layer
- Core the innermost part of the ball
- Intermediate layer every layer therebetween
- Therefore:

Glossary of terms

- "Inner cover" intermediate layer (not Cover)
- "Outer core" intermediate layer (not Core)
- "Core thickness": it must necessarily refer to the "outer core" (and, therefore, an Intermediate layer), as a "core" is defined by its diameter or its radius, but not by its thickness: this feature is, therefore, to be classified in A63B 37/0045
- "Mantel": it can refer to the cover OR the coat OR the intermediate layer: Therefore, it has to be interpreted correctly in order to know where to classify the information relating to such a "mantel"

#### Other terms:

- "Thread wound core": only used for thread wound cores with nothing inside. It is, therefore, not to be used when a thread layer is wound around a core that is not thread.
- In long patent descriptions, it is often mentioned that the invention may be made from one up to three or more layers.

However, unless every single layer explicitly appears in claims, it is not to be classified in A63B 37/0073 - A63B 37/0076 every time.

#### For example:

• If the invention is mainly manufactured with 1 layer (core) but it can also be used in golf balls with more layers (but this information does not appear in the claims), we classify as follows:

Invention information: A63B 37/0073;

Additional information: <u>A63B 37/0074</u>, <u>A63B 37/0075</u>, <u>A63B 37/0076</u>.

If the invention describes in the claims every possible case (one, two, three-layer golf balls, etc.), classification is as follows:

Invention information: A63B 37/0073, A63B 37/0074, A63B 37/0075, etc.

- "Multi-piece balls": Can be used both for three-piece balls and balls having two or more intermediate layers.
- Solid core ≠ Rigid core (<u>A63B 37/0054</u>) unless they specify that it is made of metal.
- Translucent cover A63B 37/0024
- A63B 37/0039: to be allocated when the chemistry of the intermediate layer is neither an Ionomer, nor Polyurethane, nor Polybutadien, or, at least, a very unusual one amongst the previous one (so, mixed-up with other stuff, etc.)
- Initial Velocity concerning the Cover: allocate A63B 37/0084.
- "Weight; Mass": Used for, e.g. specific weight, but not for chemical weight ratios.
- A63B 37/0067 and A63B 37/0083: Weight, just specific weight, not for ratio weight.
- MFR = Melt Flow Rate = MFI= Melt Flow Index: <u>A63B 37/0036</u> or <u>A63B 37/0048</u> (or both, if the layer is not specified).

- COR = Coefficient of Restitution -> <u>A63B 37/003</u>, <u>A63B 37/0041</u>, <u>A63B 37/0061</u> or <u>A63B 37/0078</u>.
- Flexural Modulus [Mpa=factor x psi] is different from Young modulus=Tensile modulus=Elastic modulus, Ionomer modulus, Stiffness modulus, Flexural rigidity.
- "Hardness Gradient" is most likely to be found with cores. Example: The core has a JIS-C hardness at its surface of at least 70 and a JIS-C hardness at its center that is at least 10 units lower than the hardness at the core surface.
- "Hardness distribution amongst the different ball layers" (A63B 37/0092) is to be allocated when the hardness gradient does not apply only to a specific single layer amongst several, but to the whole ball
- Rather common parameters such as "diameter of dimple", "spin rate", "rebound resilience",
   "coefficient of drag", etc. are not to be classified unless they are described in the claims, the
   abstract or the description accurately and in a quantitative manner, or unless they are mentioned
   throughout the document continuously (even if not quantitatively)... except with the "scuff
   resistance", which is usually valued with qualitative (not quantitative) terms (i.e. "good", "bad",
   "better", etc.) and is to be classified even without specific values being given therefor.
- A63B 45/00: Manufacture of golf balls. It is written in claims or abstract; or it is fully described in description.
- Material manufacturing process" for cover, internal layer or core: <u>A63B 45/00</u> and the corresponding <u>A63B 37/0023</u>, <u>A63B 37/0038</u>, <u>A63B 37/005</u> (or <u>A63B 37/0024</u>, <u>A63B 37/0039</u>, A63B 37/0051).
- "Moulding/molding compression": we do not have any specific subgroup for this: it is, however, a
  different concept from "deflection or compression" (A63B 37/0034, A63B 37/0046, A63B 37/0065,
  A63B 37/0087). These features are, therefore, to be understood as "Method for Manufacturing", for
  which the correct subgroup is A63B 45/00
- A63B 45/02: Methods or apparatus for marking golf balls. It usually goes with A63B 37/0022 (either as "Invention" or "Additional" information) if they describe the mark or it appears in the drawings.
- A circular dimple is something standard -> Do not classify this feature in any of A63B 37/0007 - A63B 37/0011.
- Interpret A63B 37/002 (i.e. "Specified dimple diameter") as" Specified dimple diameter, or length of their main axis" instead. Sometimes, dimples may have various shapes like polygonal or elliptical: in such cases perimeters, lengths, widths, major and minor axis lengths are given.
- Patents with specific drawings of one or several dimples (cross section) -> A63B 37/0012.
- If some parameters (depth, diameter) appear in drawings, accurate figures are likely to be found in the text (see A63B 37/0019, A63B 37/002):

- When the shape of the dimple is not clear, not important in that document, etc. -> Classify as "Additional Information" A63B 37/0012.

"Volume Ratio": Classified for the time being in A63B 37/0016 and A63B 37/0017.

Dimple coverage (%) = Occupation ratio -> A63B 37/0021.

Compression (A63B 37/0034, A63B 37/0046, A63B 37/0065, A63B 37/0087): it can be "PGA compression", "Atti compression", "Riehle compression" or "Load/Deflection tests.

PGA Compression = Atti Compression: A piston whose travel path is fixed compresses the ball against a spring and the spring deflection is then measured.

Riehle Compression: It measures the deformation of ball under a fixed load of 90.9 kg.

Load/Deflection tests: Same as "Riehle Compression" but with a plurality of possible loads.













