Simple devices for reducing amount of flushing water per flush (e.g. brick in cistern) are classified in [E03D 1/14](#).

Water monitoring devices, leak and/or overflow detection are classified in [E03D 1/00](#).

## E03D 3/00

**Flushing devices operated by water pressure of the water supply system [N: flushing valves not connected to the water-supply main, also if air is blown in the water seal for a quick flushing]**

This class covers the constructional details of single portable toilets, e.g. for outdoor use, trailers for providing toilet facilities as well as portable public toilet cabins as far as aspects of the toilet and its water connection are concerned. ## **E03D 9/00**

**Sanitary or other accessories for lavatories (hand tools for cleaning the toilets bowl A47K11/10; seats or covers for closets A47K13/00; body supports, other than seats for closets A47K17/02; devices for preventing contamination of drinking-water pipes E03C1/10) [N: Devices for cleaning or disinfecting the toilet room or the toilet bowl; Devices for eliminating smells (cleaning, disinfecting or deodorising the seat A47K13/30 )]**

### **Definition statement**

*This subclass/group covers:*

Accessories enhancing use comfort or security of water closets or urinals, the accessories being specially adapted for flushed toilets: devices for cleaning or disinfecting the toilet room or the toilet bowl or for eliminating smells.

Disinfecting devices, whether only dispensing while flushing or disinfecting without functional relationship to a flushing action are classified according to their placement in the flushing system in subclass [E03D 9/03](#) and parallel in [E03D 2009/024](#), [E03D 2009/026](#) and/or [E03D 2009/028](#).

Dispensers mounted inside the cistern and dispensing into the overflow pipe are classified in [E03D 9/037](#).

[E03D 9/05](#) and [E03D 9/052](#) are used indifferently and search should always take place in both groups.

Ventilation of toilets via the seat are classified in [E03D 9/05](#) and in [A47K 13/307](#).

## E03D 11/00

**Other component parts of water-closets (pipe-joints or couplings in general F16L) [N: e.g. noise-reducing means in the flushing system (noise-reducing means in combination with flushing valves E03D9/14 ), flushing pipes mounted in the bowl, seals for the bowl outlet, devices preventing overflow of the bowl contents; devices forming a water seal in the bowl after flushing, devices eliminating obstructions in the bowl outlet or preventing backflow of water and excrements from the waterpipe]**

### Definition statement

*This subclass/group covers:*

Constructional details of water closet bowls and discharge pipes; Mounting of bowls or other parts of a water closet to a support: e.g. noise-reducing means in the flushing system, flushing pipes mounted in the bowl, seals for the bowl outlet, devices preventing overflow of the bowl contents; devices forming a water seal in the bowl after flushing, devices eliminating obstructions in the bowl outlet or preventing backflow of water and excrements from the waterpipe.
